BURNS WERE FATAL.

Another Victim of the Deadly Gasoline Stove.

Mrs. Pauline Stasiak, burned in a gasoline explosion Wednesday night at her home, 161 Mettler street, died at 2:30 this morning, in terrible agony, as the result of her injuries.

She was preparing the evening meal when the tank of gasoline on the kitchen stove ignited and exploded, throwing the burning fluid over her. Her entire body was burned and broiled before neighbors could tear off her clothing. She was at once removed to the home of a neighbor and Dr. Gorny called, but, despite his efforts to save her, she died this morning. She was the mother of three children.
